#### **BARN RULES**

Our goal is to ensure every rider, parent, visitor, etc. has a safe and enjoyable time while at Daybreak Farm and Riding Academy. To help ensure that goal is met, we need to make sure everyone is aware of, understands, and follows the rules for our barn.

- No smoking.
- Drive Slowly.
- Arrive 5-10 minutes prior to scheduled start time to ensure enough time for grooming & prep. Late arrivals will have time taken off "riding" time.
- DO NOT touch the horses unless you have asked first and been given permission. This is for the health and safety of all our horses.
- All riders and guests must sign DFRA's <u>Release & Hold Harmless Agreement</u> before handling or riding any horse.
- It is a rider/parent's responsibility to ensure that all your guests have completed and signed DFRA's <u>Release</u> & <u>Hold Harmless Agreement</u>.
- Persons under 18 may not ride unsupervised without the trainer and parent permission.
- All minors must wear an approved helmet with chin harness in place when mounted. Adult riders who do not wear a helmet must sign DFRA's <u>Helmet Waiver</u> form.
- It is acceptable for parents to drop children off for lessons, however it is not acceptable to leave children for more than two hours without prior arrangement.
- Each person is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their horses, including all tack and equipment.
- Please do not bring your dog. If you must bring your dog, you must keep him/her on a leash or in your car at all times.
- Do not feed any horse but your own without permission. Do not allow your horse to "sniff noses" with other horses, as this can lead to injuries.
- Your safety and the safety of others is important, so you agree to follow any instructions or suggestions for safety made by our staff.
- Each person will respect any posted barn hours and closed days (Monday.)

Note: Typical boots with faux leather from department stores (Wal-mart, Target, etc) are NOT as safe as real riding boots. Real riding boots will help prevent the rider's foot from sliding through the stirrup and becoming caught.

# WINTER RIDING CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Riders who are too cold to ride will have their riding time shortened. Be sure your rider is dressed for success!

# Recommended clothing layers:

- -long sleeve shirt or UnderArmor type shirt
- -zippered jacket
- -vest
- -earmuff / headbands
- -winter riding gloves are required
- -riders may layer fleece leggings under regular riding pants



Non-Approved Winter Riding Clothing:

- -v neck shirts
- -bulky sweatshirts or coats
- -non-riding gloves-slick tights w/o kneepatches





Winter coats or hoodies & earmuffs may be worn for grooming but must be taken off for riding.

Bulky outerlayers prevent instructors from properly evaluating rider's posture.
