

## **BARN RULES**

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Our goal is to ensure every rider, parent, visitor, etc. has a safe and enjoyable time while at Daybreak Farm and Riding Academy. To help ensure that goal is met, we need to make sure everyone is aware of, understands, and follows the rules for our barn.


- No smoking.
- Drive Slowly.
- Arrive 5-10 minutes prior to scheduled start time to ensure enough time for grooming & prep. Late arrivals will have time taken off "riding" time.
- DO NOT touch the horses unless you have asked first and been given permission. This is for the health and safety of all our horses.
- All riders and guests must sign DFRA's Release & Hold Harmless Agreement before handling or riding any horse.
- It is a rider/parent's responsibility to ensure that all your guests have completed and signed DFRA's Release & Hold Harmless Agreement.
- Persons under 18 may not ride unsupervised without the trainer and parent permission.
- All minors must wear an approved helmet with chin harness in place when mounted. Adult riders who do not wear a helmet must sign DFRA's Helmet Waiver form.
- It is acceptable for parents to drop children off for lessons, however it is not acceptable to leave children for more than two hours without prior arrangement.
- Each person is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their horses, including all tack and equipment.
- Please do not bring your dog. If you must bring your dog, you must keep him/her on a leash or in your car at all times.
- Do not feed any horse but your own without permission. Do not allow your horse to "sniff noses" with other horses, as this can lead to injuries.
- Your safety and the safety of others is important, so you agree to follow any instructions or suggestions for safety made by our staff.
- Each person will respect any posted barn hours and closed days (Monday.)

## Release and Hold Harmless Agreement

_____	I agree to hold harmless and indemnify DFRA and any and all DFRA employees, contractors, and volunteers, and further release them from any liability or responsibility for accident, damage, injury, or illness to the Undersigned or to any horse owned by the undersigned or to any family member or spectator accompanying the undersigned on the premises.
_____	I give DFRA, its owners, employees, contractors, and volunteers my permission to initiate emergency first aid treatment for my children, my animals, and myself in case of an accident. They also have my permission to authorize emergency medical treatment by qualified medical personnel for my children or myself, and veterinary treatment by qualified veterinary personnel for my animals.
_____	I understand that I am fully responsible for any guests that I may have on the property. I understand that I am fully responsible for informing my guest(s) of all risks related to the handling or riding of horses. I understand that I am fully responsible for informing my guest(s) about horse's temperament, training, habits, and for determining that the guest is sufficiently experienced to ride the horse.



Note: Everyday tights are NOT riding pants. The recommended tights have suede knee patches with extra grip in the fabric to keep the rider from slipping in the saddle.

# WINTER RIDING CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Riders who are too cold to ride will have their riding time shortened. Be sure your rider is dressed for success!


## Recommended clothing layers:

- long sleeve shirt or UnderArmor type shirt
- zippered jacket
- vest
- earmuff / headbands
- winter riding gloves are required
- riders may layer fleece leggings under regular riding pants

- v neck shirts
- bulky sweatshirts or coats
- non-riding gloves
- slick tights w/o knee patches
